

# Bed and Breakfast Quilts

## Full Day Workshop with Mimi Dietrich



### Description

Gather your favorite fabrics together and make this scrappy little quilt based on the cover quilt from Mimi's book *Bed and Breakfast Quilts*. In the first half of the class, we will machine piece blocks for the center of the quilt using a fast technique called "Mary Triangles". In the second half of the class, we will learn to applique the vine, leaves, and hearts around the border. The quilt is made with Thimbleberries fabrics, but it looks great with any collection of fabrics. This is a fun class for all skill levels.

### Materials List

#### Book

- *Bed and Breakfast Quilts* (this book is out of print and is not required for class)

#### Fabric

- Project finished size: 39" x 49"
- 12 fat quarters (3 red, 2 light green, 2 dark green, 2 blue, 2 gold, 1 brown)
- 2 yards light background fabric
- 1/2 yard of green for inner border and vine
- 1/4 yard red for binding

#### Class Supplies

- Basic sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter, mat, and ruler
- Sewing machine and extension cord for first half of class
- Thread to coordinate with your background fabric
- Full bobbin of thread for your machine
- Thread to match or blend with appliqué fabrics
- #10 Straw or Milliners needles (or your favorite applique needles)
- Small sharp scissors that cut to the point
- Thimble
- Glue stick
- Fabric marking pencil
- 12" square of freezer paper
- 5 1/2" square of template plastic (measure and cut accurately)
- Little bag for trash

#### Before Class

- Wash and iron all fabrics.
