

# A Quilter's Diary: Written in Stitches

## Full Day Workshop with Mimi Dietrich



### Description

Stitch the story of your life by starting your own Quilter's Diary. Mimi will help you choose blocks that tell your story, help you plan your own Quilter's Diary, and show you how to cut and organize your blocks. This full day workshop includes hand stitching an applique block. This is a class for all skill levels.

### Materials List

#### Book

- A Quilter's Diary Written in Stitches (available in class)

#### Fabric

- Choose a favorite multi-colored fabric to use as your inspiration fabric. Buy two yards to use in some of your quilt blocks and for your quilt borders.
- 1 yard of "background" fabric to use for both appliqué and patchwork squares
- 10 fat quarters that coordinate with your inspiration fabric

#### Supplies

- Sticky notes (Post-it Notes)
- Mat, ruler, rotary cutter
- Basic sewing supplies for appliqué (needles, pins, thimble, scissors)
- Thread to match your fabrics
- Pencil
- Fabric marker
- Glue Stick
- Freezer paper

#### Before Class:

- Wash and iron all fabrics.
- Cut out four squares 7" x 7" from background fabric. Please cut, do not tear
